NEW STUDENT ACCOMMODATION – BURWOOD

We are building a new student residence at the Melbourne Burwood Campus that will provide an additional 575 beds from Trimester 1, 2017 to help meet increasing demand. This will increase the number of available beds at Burwood to almost 1200.

This new facility will provide new apartment configurations, including 2, 4 and 6-bedroom apartments. Each apartment will feature private bedrooms and study spaces, with a shared kitchen, bathroom and lounge. Full Wi-Fi coverage will be available throughout the complex.

Features include:

- a safe and secure environment, including 24-hour staff support
- sustainability elements including rooftop solar panels, and landscaped outdoor entertainment area with barbeque, seating and lights
- a central common area with lounge and kitchen/dining zones and an open plan recreation space with flexible furniture and a games area
- various study rooms equipped with modern technology
- laundrette with washing machines and dryer.
