- Free Apps: Adobe Reader, Jabber, Lync, HopTo, SkyDrive Pro, Puffin Web browser.
- Paid Apps: Notes Plus (\$10.49), GoodReader for iPad (\$5.49).
- Apple built-in apps: AirDrop, iMessages.
- We use Air Squirrel Reflector (\$12.99, Mac & PC versions) to mirror our iPad onto the larger projector screen.

Adobe Reader

This is the same as the free Adobe Reader you can get on your computer. You can add mark-up, text and signatures. There are also other apps available that let you create or edit PDFs.

Dropbox

A cloud-based storage service for files such as documents, photos, videos etc.
