



This Regulation is made pursuant to Statute 6.1 – *University Property, Facilities, Fees and Charges*.

1. The ~~Chief Operating Officer-Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic)~~ shall be responsible for:
 - (a) establishing Information Communication and Technology facilities, comprising computer infrastructure, networks, software and communications services within the University; and
 - (b) administering the policies and procedures governing the conditions of Information and Communications Technology use, as he or she deems appropriate.
2. The ~~Chief Operating Officer- Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic)~~ may delegate authority to the ~~Director, Information Technology Services Division- Chief Information Officer~~ or other person or persons to administer the policies and procedures governing the conditions of ~~I~~information and ~~C~~ommunications ~~T~~echnology use as he or she deems appropriate.
3. The University's ~~I~~information and ~~C~~ommunications ~~T~~echnology facilities may be used by:
 - (a) enrolled students;
 - (b) staff; and
 - (c) others as approved by the ~~Chief Operating Officer- Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic)~~.
4. Users of the University's ~~I~~information ~~C~~ommunications and ~~T~~echnology facilities:
 - (a) may at any time be required by the ~~Chief Operating Officer-Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic), Chief Information Officer, and University Librarian~~ to produce evidence of their identity; and
 - (b) must comply with all relevant University policies and procedures.
