It is also available as a single unit for those wishing to undertake a formal Master's level unit, or as a conference for those who simply wish to undertake individual professional development without formally enrolling in the unit. Conference attendees will not be eligible for subsequent recognition of prior learning (RPL).

This Masterclass will provide those who attend with an opportunity to hear from leaders in the Australian healthcare system and to learn about current and future challenges in Australian healthcare.

Program highlights include discussion about:

- The importance of the patient/consumer in our healthcare system
- The challenge of clinical engagement in safety and quality
- Leadership of self
- Leadership within the organisational setting

Attendees will be encouraged to develop their thinking about their own leadership, whilst learning practical leadership skills from each other and from an outstanding faculty. The Masterclass will also provide an opportunity to develop and extend professional and personal networks.

Cost

The all-expenses cost of the residential is \$5,500 or early-bird cost \$5,300 if you enrol in the unit by 8th April, 2016. This includes meals and accommodation at the Waurn Ponds Estate.
