Who might apply for the Associate Degree?

You can undertake Deakin's Associate Degrees regardless of your previous educational background. These courses are targeted at students who do not satisfy the usual university entry requirements, such as:

- students who have completed Year 12 but have achieved an ATAR score which is insufficient to gain normal entry;
- students who have not completed year 12 and who may have been working for a number of years;
- students who have completed a VET qualification or program offered by TAFE or private provider;
- or students who are undertaking a training course at a TAFE.

Applications are particularly encouraged through the Access and Equity Program for individuals who might not otherwise enjoy the benefits that flow from participation in higher education.

In the Associate Degree you commence studying units from your target degree from day one, and you are provided with a supported and guaranteed pathway in a university environment.

Where can the Associate Degree take you?

- Bachelor of Education (Primary) (E359)

On completion of the Associate Degree you will be able to enter your target bachelor degree with up to 18 months credit for prior learning.
