2017 Offers and enrolment information

Enrolling to uni for the first time can be very exciting but also completely nerve-racking!

Below are answers to some of the questions students may have about the enrolment process.

When and how do students receive their offer?

VTAC will release offers to students on 18 January at 2pm. Deakin University sends out offers, including information about how to enrol, by no later than 5pm on Tuesday 19 January. Students who have provided a mobile number to VTAC will also receive an SMS to notify them that a Deakin offer has been sent to them via email. To accept their offer students need to enrol by 5pm Monday 30 January 2017.

What information is in the offer email?

The offer email includes all the information needed to enrol online, including the student ID number, information on how to create usernames and passwords, and details of information sessions, if the faculty is holding any.

Information sessions

Information sessions will be held between Monday 23 January and Friday 27 January.

The information sessions will cover topics like how to enrol, how to choose subjects, how to get set up online and how to get a student card. The information session details will be included in the student's offer email.

How do students enrol?

At Deakin, students can enrol from anywhere in the world. They will need internet access and, when they complete the electronic Commonwealth Assistance Form (eCAF – HECS-HELP form), they will need their Tax File Number (TFN).

Where can students go for assistance?

PATHWAYS

Our new pathways tool will be live on the Deakin website in time for Change of Preference. It will enable students to find alternative pathways to Deakin if they didn't get the required ATAR score. Students can put their desired Deakin course in and the tool shows them the variety of pathways that will lead to their desired course, with different locations, entry requirements and time to get into their degree. DEAKIN ACCELERATE – IMPORTANT MESSAGE FOR APPLICANTS

This year, the application deadline for Deakin Accelerate falls on the same day as the release of end of year VASS statements (12 December). Normally students are required to include their VASS statements with their Deakin Accelerate application. But, given that the clash of dates will make this difficult, students who wish to apply for Deakin Accelerate can apply now (or up until the 12 December deadline) and submit their VASS statement separately, once they receive it. VASS statements can be sent to accelerate@deakin.edu.au and will be attached to the student's Deakin Accelerate application upon receipt.
