Regulation 3.1(3) – Pro Vice-Chancellors



This regulation is made pursuant to Statute 3.1 – Officers and Staff of the University.

- 1. Council may, on the advice of the Vice-Chancellor:
 - (a) appoint one or more Pro Vice-Chancellors; and
 - (b) grant the rank and title of Professor to a Pro Vice-Chancellor.
- 2. A Pro Vice-Chancellor shall:
 - have such powers, functions and duties as are conferred by <u>the</u> Council, <u>or</u> prescribed by <u>university</u> Statute or <u>university</u> regulation <u>and or</u> as are delegated by notice in writing to him or her by the Vice-Chancellor; and
 - (b) resign from such other positions and relinquish such other responsibilities as directed by the Vice-Chancellor upon taking up the duties of office.
- 3. If a Pro Vice-Chancellor proposes to be absent from the University:
 - (a) for a period of less than or equal to <u>3three</u> months, the Vice-Chancellor may appoint an Acting Pro Vice-Chancellor to act in his or her place during that absence; or
 - (b) for a period of more than <u>3three</u> months, Council on the advice of the Vice-Chancellor may appoint an Acting Pro Vice-Chancellor to act in his or her place during that absence.
- 4. The Vice-Chancellor may appoint an Acting Pro Vice-Chancellor to act:
 - (a) during any vacancy in the office of a Pro Vice-Chancellor, or
 - (b) during any inability of a Pro Vice-Chancellor to act, other than as described in section 3.
- 5. A person nominated or appointed pursuant to sections 3 or 4 shall, during the absence of the Pro Vice-Chancellor referred to therein, exercise all powers, carry out all the functions and be subject to the duties of the office of that Pro Vice-Chancellor.
