



This regulation is made pursuant to Statute 3.1 – *Officers and Staff of the University*.

1. Council may, on the advice of the Vice-Chancellor:
 - (a) appoint one or more Pro Vice-Chancellors; and
 - (b) grant the rank and title of Professor to a Pro Vice-Chancellor.
2. A Pro Vice-Chancellor shall:
 - (a) have such powers, functions and duties as are conferred by the Council, or prescribed by university ~~Statute~~ or university regulation and-or as are delegated by notice in writing to him or her by the Vice-Chancellor; and
 - (b) resign from such other positions and relinquish such other responsibilities as directed by the Vice-Chancellor upon taking up the duties of office.
3. If a Pro Vice-Chancellor proposes to be absent from the University:
 - (a) for a period of less than or equal to three months, the Vice-Chancellor may appoint an Acting Pro Vice-Chancellor to act in his or her place during that absence; or
 - (b) for a period of more than three months, Council on the advice of the Vice-Chancellor may appoint an Acting Pro Vice-Chancellor to act in his or her place during that absence.
4. The Vice-Chancellor may appoint an Acting Pro Vice-Chancellor to act:
 - (a) during any vacancy in the office of a Pro Vice-Chancellor, or
 - (b) during any inability of a Pro Vice-Chancellor to act, other than as described in section 3.
5. A person nominated or appointed pursuant to sections 3 or 4 shall, during the absence of the Pro Vice-Chancellor referred to therein, exercise all powers, carry out all the functions and be subject to the duties of the office of that Pro Vice-Chancellor.
