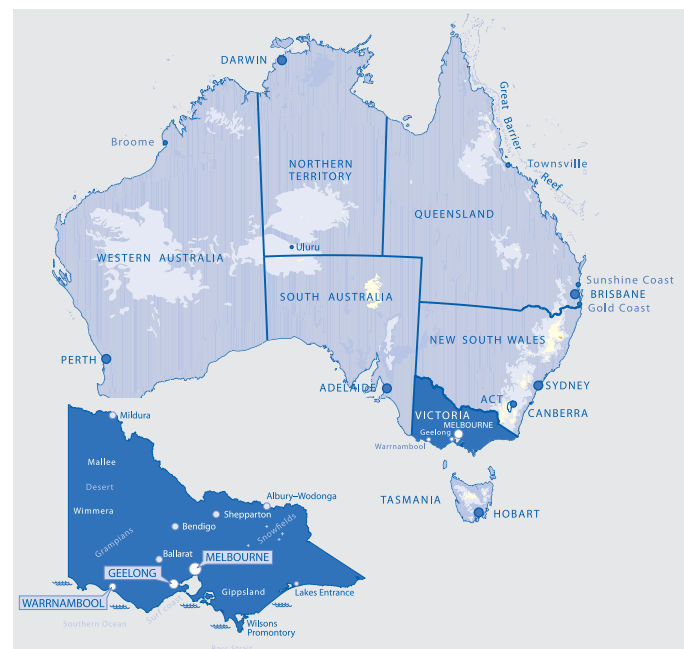
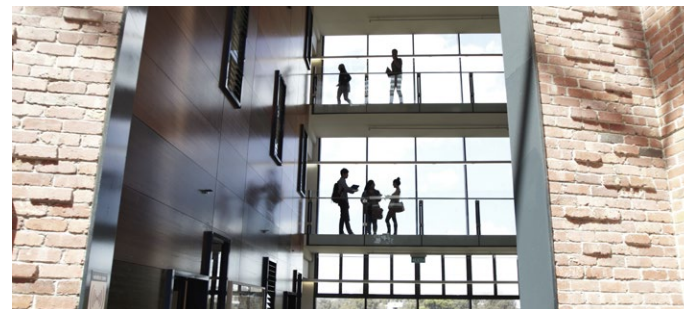

## SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES

International students studying at Deakin are eligible to apply for a range of scholarships to assist them in their studies. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit, and are based on different selection criteria determined by each faculty such as course, campus, country of origin, industry and research focus. Deakin scholarships for international students include scholarships awarded through the Deakin University International Scholars Program (DUISP), scholarships offered in conjunction with leading industry bodies, and international research scholarships for research degree students.

## DEAKIN UNIVERSITY ENGLISH LANGUAGE INSTITUTE

Deakin University English Language Institute (DUELI) prepares students who may need additional support in the English language for entry into degree-level courses at Deakin University and other tertiary institutions in Australia. # A SAMPLE OF COURSES

## FACULTY OF ARTS AND EDUCATION

Programs from this faculty in the humanities, performing and creative arts, social sciences, and education across disciplines are vital to making Australia an equitable, humane and innovative society.

### BACHELOR OF CREATIVE ARTS (VISUAL ARTS)

Students will learn an array of visual art techniques and develop a solid knowledge of contemporary art theory by combining cutting-edge theory with specialised studio practice incorporating digital technologies. Combining a major sequence in visual arts and education studies can qualify students to teach visual arts in schools and other educational settings.

### BACHELOR OF ARTS (MEDIA AND COMMUNICATION)

The course is designed for students to graduate with a multi-skilled qualification appropriate for the fast paced and rapidly changing media and communication industry. Students will be equipped with diverse and integrated skills through a combination of theoretical and practical study, taught in purpose-built state-of-the-art studios.

### BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (PRIMARY)

The primary education course is a specialist professional qualification, with students participating in a highly professional experience program.

### MASTER OF EDUCATION

Deakin's Education courses have an international reputation for providing high-quality professional development programs for teachers, with a strong commitment to distance education and flexible learning.

## FACULTY OF BUSINESS AND LAW

The Faculty of Business and Law offers undergraduate, postgraduate and executive development programs designed to extend the creative, analytical, interpersonal and technical skills that underpin business careers and professional success.

### BACHELOR OF LAWS

Deakin's Bachelor of Laws is designed to produce first-class commercial lawyers. The course provides in-depth studies in each of the major areas of legal practice including a special emphasis on practical legal skills training. It is also one of the few courses in Australia with a specific and exclusive focus on commercial law.

### BACHELOR OF MANAGEMENT

The Bachelor of Management is for those aiming to work in a management role. The course will enable students to acquire and master a solid understanding of the intellectual foundations of the study of management and its main components.

### BACHELOR OF COMMERCE

A flexible structure for this course allows students to specialise in areas as they progress through the degree, maximising skills and employment opportunities. A valuable business internship is also available to provide business experience in the area of specialisation.

### MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (INTERNATIONAL)

The course has been specially designed to give high-performing students an opportunity to gain industry experience as part of a world-class MBA. It features a research project option, which can allow for research into specific organisational issues, and may allow students to articulate into a higher degree by research. Emphasis is placed on issues associated with international business management.

## FACULTY OF HEALTH

The Faculty of Health comprises the five schools of Exercise and Nutrition Sciences; Health and Social Development; Medicine; Nursing and Midwifery and Psychology.

### BACHELOR OF MEDICINE BACHELOR OF SURGERY

This is a four-year graduate entry program for students wishing to qualify as medical practitioners. Deakin Medical School graduates will be well prepared to work as interns in urban or rural hospitals. They will be equipped to enter training programs for a diverse range of medical careers, including general practice, surgery, pathology, emergency medicine, obstetrics and gynaecology, paediatrics, anaesthetics, geriatric medicine, radiology, occupational and rehabilitation medicine and many other specialities.

### BACHELOR OF NURSING

Deakin's Bachelor of Nursing is one of the best in Australia, with graduates being highly regarded for their professionalism and ability to provide patient care. In recent years, 100 per cent of Deakin nursing graduates seeking work have found jobs within three months of graduation.

### BACHELOR OF HEALTH SCIENCES

The health sciences course is ideal for students who wish to study a range of health issues. The flexible structure allows students to cover a wide range of areas in health sciences, or to concentrate on two specified specialised areas.

### MASTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Deakin's multidisciplinary Master of Public Health degree gives graduates a broad-based understanding of health in populations. Students also gain the opportunity for in-depth study and research in a public health specialisation.

## FACULTY OF SCIENCE, ENGINEERING AND BUILT ENVIRONMENT

The Schools of Architecture and Built Environment; Life and Environmental Sciences; Engineering and Information Technology make up this faculty.

### BACHELOR OF DESIGN (ARCHITECTURE)

Comprising of cutting edge content, the latest research and designed with a global perspective, the Bachelor of Design places emphasis on real application. Students will explore architectural ideas, history, philosophy, design, communication as well as building science and technology.

### BACHELOR OF BIOMEDICAL SCIENCE

The Bachelor of Biomedical Science is a vibrant, relevant and topical program. It follows a multidisciplinary path that enables students to learn about their chosen fields of study from both scientific and health perspectives.

### MASTER OF ENGINEERING
