

SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES

International students studying at Deakin are eligible to apply for a range of scholarships to assist them in their studies. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit, and are based on different selection criteria determined by each faculty such as course, campus, country of origin, industry and research focus. Deakin scholarships for international students include scholarships awarded through the Deakin University International Scholars Program (DUISP), scholarships offered in conjunction with leading industry bodies, and international research scholarships for research degree students.

DEAKIN UNIVERSITY ENGLISH LANGUAGE INSTITUTE

Deakin University English Language Institute (DUELI) prepares students who may need additional support in the English language for entry into degree-level courses at Deakin University and other tertiary institutions in Australia.
