



The first stage of the new **Deakin Elite Sports Precinct** has opened at our Geelong Waurm Ponds Campus. The \$8.4 million precinct has been developed to provide state-of-the-art world-class facilities for exercise and sport science and physical education teaching students, as well as student engagement and community sport.

The redevelopment includes an MCG-sized AFL oval, a FIFA-grade soccer pitch, an eight-lane 400-metre athletics track and a stunning outdoor, trackside teaching facility.
