Much of Professor Badeng Nima's research lies in the issue of how to develop education in order to help children develop common knowledge and an ability to live a fulfilling life in a multicultural society. He takes an interdisciplinary approach and combines perspectives from pedagogy, psychology, sociology, economics, philosophy, politics and history to study different cultures, for example, Tibetan and Chinese cultures, and also other eastern and western cultures. He has also researched social problems related to economy, agriculture and gender.

Professor Badeng Nima is the Dean of Faculty of Education, the Director of the Institute of Education, Sichuan Normal University, and the Director of Research Center for Multi-Culture which is the key research institute of philosophy and social sciences in Sichuan province.

Professor Nima is an experienced teacher and researcher who has had a wide range of positions, from a primary school teacher, to a headmaster of local school in Tibet, to a professor and dean of the Faculty of Education at Sichuan Normal University, and supervisor of doctoral students at Sichuan Normal University and Southwest University of China
