To be eligible for this scholarship you must:

- Be an Australian citizen or holder of an Australian permanent humanitarian visa
- Be a first year student enrolled in the Bachelor of Medicine Bachelor of Surgery in a Commonwealth Supported Place
- Agree to your name being released to the Dr Gilbert M Davis Trust if your application is successful

Selection Criteria:

- The terms of the award state that applicants who have lived in the Shire of Indigo, (the locations of Dr Davis' practice) should be favoured
- Students, who have already received a scholarship or award, including students with Medical Rural Bonded Scholarships, are not eligible to apply
- Applicants who meet the eligibility criteria will be assessed by a panel from Deakin Medical School using a competitive process on the basis of academic merit.
- Applications of more than 300 words will not be considered
