Deakin University

Regulation 3.1(5) – Professors and Emeritus Professors



This regulation is made pursuant to Statute 3.1 – Officers and Staff of the University.

In this regulation:

"**Retired Professor**" means a professor's cessation of employment with the University in circumstances where the Council is satisfied that the professor is unlikely to re-enter the academic workforce by accepting a substantive academic position with another University within Australia.

- 1. Council may, on the recommendation of the Vice-Chancellor, appoint such persons as it sees fit to the rank and title of professor in addition to those persons appointed as professors by virtue of office pursuant to <u>Uuniversity Ss</u>tatutes and <u>university</u> regulations.
- 2. Council may confer the title of Emeritus Professor upon any Retired Professor of the University in recognition of distinguished academic service to his or her discipline and/or to the University.
- 3. An Emeritus Professor shall, for all purposes of courtesy and on ceremonial occasions, be regarded as a professor of the University but shall not be a member of the Academic Board or a member of any Faculty Board.
- 4. The title Emeritus Professor shall be conferred in accordance with criteria and process set out in the policies and procedures of the University.
