## Course Requirements:

S449 Bachelor of Planning (Honours) comprises a total of 32 credit points of study which must include the following:

- 24 core units (totalling 28 credit points, including 4 core units of 2 credit points each)
- 1 zero-credit point Safety Induction Program unit, and
- 4 credit points of electives (level 4 elective units)

To exit with the S349 *Bachelor of Design (Urban Studies)*, students must complete 24 credit points of study, which must contain:

- 20 core units (totalling 23 credit points, including 3 core units of 2 credit points each),
- 1 zero-credit point Safety Induction Program unit, and
- 1 elective unit (level 3 or 4)
