Regulation 2.3(3) - Schools



This Regulation is made pursuant to Statute 2.3 - The Faculties.

- 1 The Vice-Chancellor may establish or disestablish a School within a Faculty.
- 2 Subject to the general superintendence of the Principal Officer of the Faculty, Schools shall:
 - (a) coordinate their academic affairs in accordance with the University's statutes, regulations, policies and procedures; policies established by the Planning and Resources Committee, the Academic Board or the Council and the rules established by the Faculty Board;
 - (a) establish and maintain high standards of teaching, student engagement, research, consultancy and community service;
 - (b) deliver high quality teaching, supervision and assessment to enrolled students; and
 - (c) prepare a report to the Faculty annually on the activities of the School for the preceding calendar year.
- 3 The Faculty shall:
 - (a) annually review the <u>performance of its Schools in terms of teaching, research and service</u>

 <u>performance</u>teaching and professional activities, research and community involvement of its Schools; and
 - (b) be responsible for overseeing the operational and financial management of its Schools.
- 4. The Vice-Chancellor may initiate a review of a School at any time.
