## Insurance for Students on Placements / Work Experience

The Deakin University insurance policies provide insurance cover for students during medical placement, community placement, practical placement, enterprise experience and work experience authorised by Deakin University.

Insurance cover is provided under the following policies:

- Public and Products Liability provides cover for the legal liability to pay damages
  or compensation in respect of personal injury and/or damage to property
  occurring during placements and work experience;
- Public Liability to Host Employers provides cover for the legal liability to pay for increased workers' compensation premiums incurred by the Host Employer resulting from personal injury of students during placements and work experience;
- Professional Indemnity provides cover for the civil liability resulting from the conduct of the professional services provided during placements and work experience;
- Professional Indemnity Medical Malpractice provides cover for the civil liability resulting from the conduct of the healthcare services provided during placements and work experience;
- Personal Accident provides capital benefits, weekly benefits and injury
  assistance benefits following an injury during placements and work experience,
  but does not replace Medicare or any Private Health Insurance.
- International Travel provides cover for medical and additional expenses, emergency travel assistance, loss of baggage and loss of personal effects during authorised international travel as part of placements and work experience.

All of the Deakin University's insurance policies provide cover for the period 1 November in the current year to 1 November in the following year. Our most recent certificates of currency are available upon request.
