Reporting Requirements			
Key Performance Indicators (KPIs)	The Funding Rules now include clauses relating to KPIs for Research Hubs. KPI requirements were previously detailed only in the funding agreement for this scheme, so the inclusion of these clauses in the Funding Rules will provide greater clarity for applicants. (B12.1)		
Performance Reviews	The Funding Rules now include clauses providing that Research Hubs may be subject to ad hoc performance reviews. (B12.3)
