Regulation 2.3(3) – Schools



This Regulation is made pursuant to Statute 2.3 - The Faculties.

- 1. The Vice-Chancellor may establish or disestablish a School within a Faculty.
- 2. The Dean\_shall make a recommendation to the Vice-Chancellor in respect of the appointment of a Head of School the principal officers of the School. The Vice-Chancellor shall appoint the Head of School principal officers of the School.

3. The Head of School shall convene and preside at all meetings of the School.

- 4.2. Subject to the general superintendence of the Dean Principal Officer of the Faculty, Schools shall:
  - (a) coordinate their academic affairs in accordance with policies established by the <u>Planning and</u> <u>Resources Committee, the</u> Academic Board<u>or the and</u> Council, and the rules established by the Faculty Board;
  - (b) establish and maintain high standards of teaching, student engagement, research, consultancy and community service;
  - (c) deliver high quality teaching, supervision and assessment to enrolled students; and
  - (d) prepare a report to the Faculty annually on the activities of the School for the preceding calendar year.
- 5.3. The Faculty shall:
  - (a) annually review the teaching and professional activities, research and community involvement of its Schools; and
  - (b) be responsible for overseeing the operational and financial management of its Schools.
- 6.4. The Vice-Chancellor may initiate a review of a School at any time.
