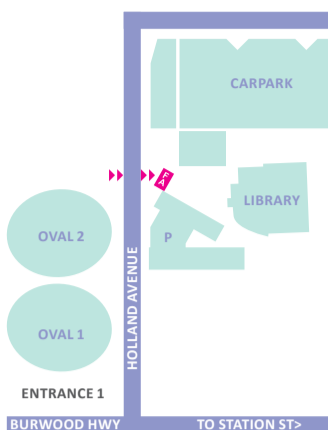
DEAKIN UNIVERSITY ART GALLERY

The Deakin University Art Gallery is located in the heart of the Melbourne Burwood Campus, providing an exciting venue for the University's program of exhibitions and visual arts events. These include curated exhibitions drawn from the University's art collection, group and solo exhibitions by significant contemporary Australian artists, travelling exhibitions and selected student, staff and alumni work.

The Deakin University Art Collection comprises over 2000 artworks, principally by Australian contemporary artists, which are displayed throughout the University's campuses. Maintaining and developing the Collection demonstrates the University's interest in the study, patronage and advancement of the visual arts in Australia. The Collection reflects the cultural aspirations of Deakin University and its strategic goals of Learning, Ideas, Value and Experience. The Collection is administered by the Deakin Art Collection and Galleries Unit located at the Melbourne Burwood Campus.

All programs are FREE of charge and can be tailor-made to suit your needs.

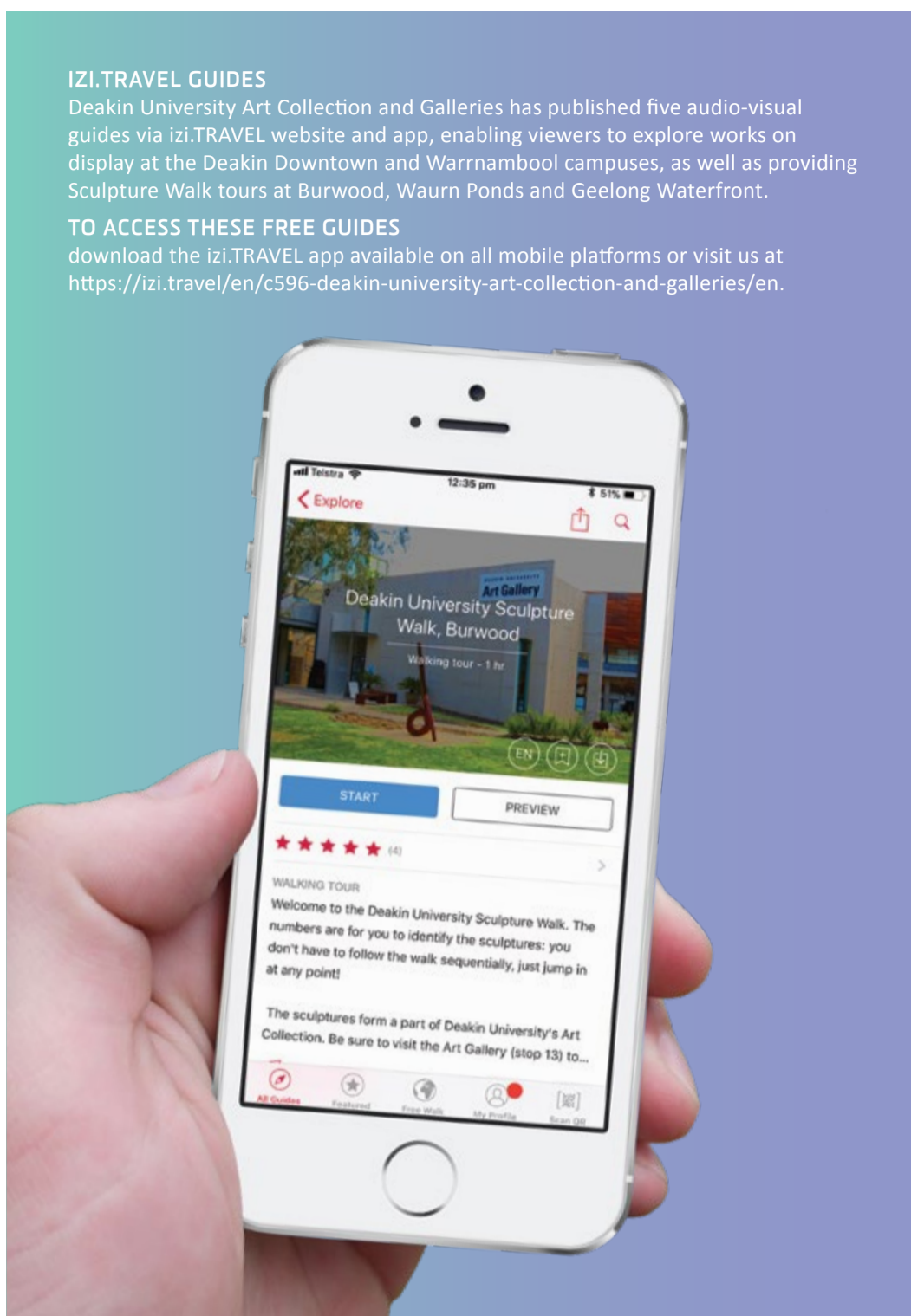


Image: Deakin University Art Gallery storerooms



Image: The Drawing Room exhibition installation

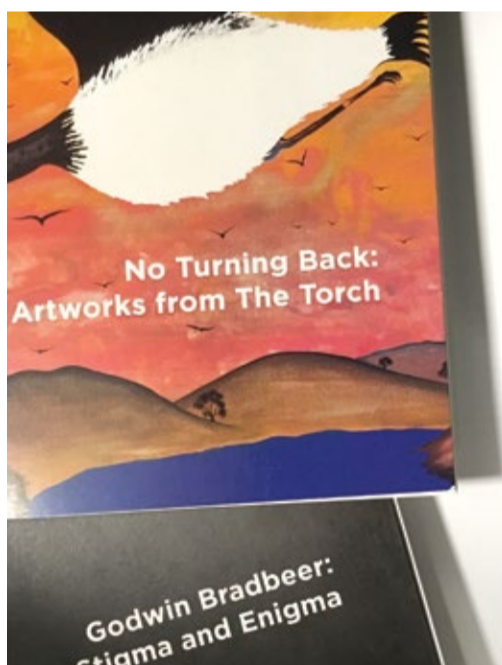
