NEW COURSES AND MAJOR SEQUENCES (FROM TRIMESTER 1, 2017)

Introducing the brand new Bachelor of Software Engineering (Honours). This innovative four-year course will be offered at both the Melbourne Burwood and Cloud campuses. Focusing on cyberphysical systems, the Internet of Things and robotics applications, graduates will be highly sought after for their ability to create the smart software and systems of the future. They will drive the design and development of computing solutions that interact with people, environments and other technologies, furthering

advancements in the development of self-driving cars, smart homes, robotic surgery and precision agriculture.

Students enrolled in the Bachelor of Science can elect to study a new major sequence in geography at the Melbourne Burwood Campus. Students will also have the option to undertake major sequences in freshwater biology and fisheries and aquaculture at the Geelong Waurn Ponds Campus.

NEW CAMPUS OFFERING (FROM TRIMESTER 1, 2017)

Deakin's nationally recognised and field leading Bachelor of Exercise and Sport Science/Bachelor of Business (Sport Management) is now available at our Geelong Waurn Ponds Campus! The course is designed for students who wish to gain a broad understanding of sport through learning about both the business and management of sporting organisations and as well as the science behind elite performance and participation in sport.

From 2017, Deakin's Bachelor of
Environmental Science (Marine Biology)
will be offered at the Geelong Waurn
Ponds Campus, in addition to the
Warrnambool Campus. Students will
have hands-on learning experiences on
the Great Ocean Road and study how
marine organisms interact with their
living and non-living environments and
how marine ecosystems functions.

COURSE AMENDMENTS

(FROM TRIMESTER 1, 2017)

Deakin's **Bachelor of Health Sciences** is changing. From 2017 the degree will include a newly enhanced suite of six compulsory units, scaffolded across the three year levels of the degree, focusing on graduate outcomes and the professional competencies underpinning modern health practice. In addition, students will select two of 12 available major sequences (spanning a range of disciplines from the health and social services sector) to tailor their study to align with their interests and career goals. Five of the majors available in the Bachelor of Health Sciences will be taught completely via our Cloud Campus from 2017, meaning students can study wherever, whenever.

From Trimester 1 2017 the Bachelor of IT Security will be known as the **Bachelor of Cyber Security**. Throughout the course students will continue to learn cyber security concepts, industry practices as well as the techniques and tools available to prevent and mitigate cyber security threats. Students will have opportunities to practice their skills through 'ethical hacking' challenges on a secure network.

The **Bachelor of Commerce** will undergo some changes from Trimester 1 2017. The number of core units will be reduced from 10 to eight and each major sequence will now comprise eight units instead of five, which means students can study a maximum of two majors. We have also refined the major sequences available and will now offer: accounting; business analytics; commercial law; economics; finance; financial planning; human resource management; international trade; management; management information systems; and marketing.



- Deakin Student Support Scholarship: financial support of up to \$10 000 per year


Deakin also offers a range of generous donor scholarships that support excellence, achievement, hardship, students enrolled in a particular course, or from a specific region or background.


