#### Which Honours course should I be applying for?

#### H400 Bachelor of Health Sciences (Honours)

Students from Deakin course codes H300 and D391 or who wish to undertake honours in health promotion, family society & health, human services, or people society and disability must apply for H400.

#### H412 Bachelor of Public Health and Health Promotion (Honours)

Students from Deakin course codes H313, D381 or D388 who wish to undertake honours in health promotion must apply for H412.

Students from any other Deakin course codes not listed above or from other universities who wish to undertake honours in health promotion, family society & health, human services or people society & disability must apply for H400.

#### How do I apply for Honours?

All prospective honours students must apply directly to Deakin University. To apply please follow the steps below:

1. Access Deakin's online application portal via: <www.deakin.edu.au/applicantportal>.

**2**. Select the 'Register' link to activate a username and password to gain entry to the online application.

NOTE: Current Deakin students - your Deakin username and password will not gain you access to the online application.

**3.** Select the 'Login' link and complete all of the questions on the online application. NOTE: Referee details are

not required.

**4**. Please ignore this final step if your undergraduate studies were undertaken at Deakin University.

The final step requires applicants to upload scanned **certified** copies of their University academic transcript(s).

#### What is the deadline to apply for Honours?

The closing date to apply for 2014 entry to H400 or H412 is Sunday 30 November 2014.

#### When will I be advised if my application has been successful?

Prospective students will be advised of the outcome of their application in late December 2014. Notification will be sent to the email address you nominated in your online application. All prospective students who are made an offer will be sent an honours booklet outlining the projects available.

Students will be requested to nominate which projects they would like to undertake on a preference form. Once all preferences have been returned, the honours team will allocate projects and advise students.
