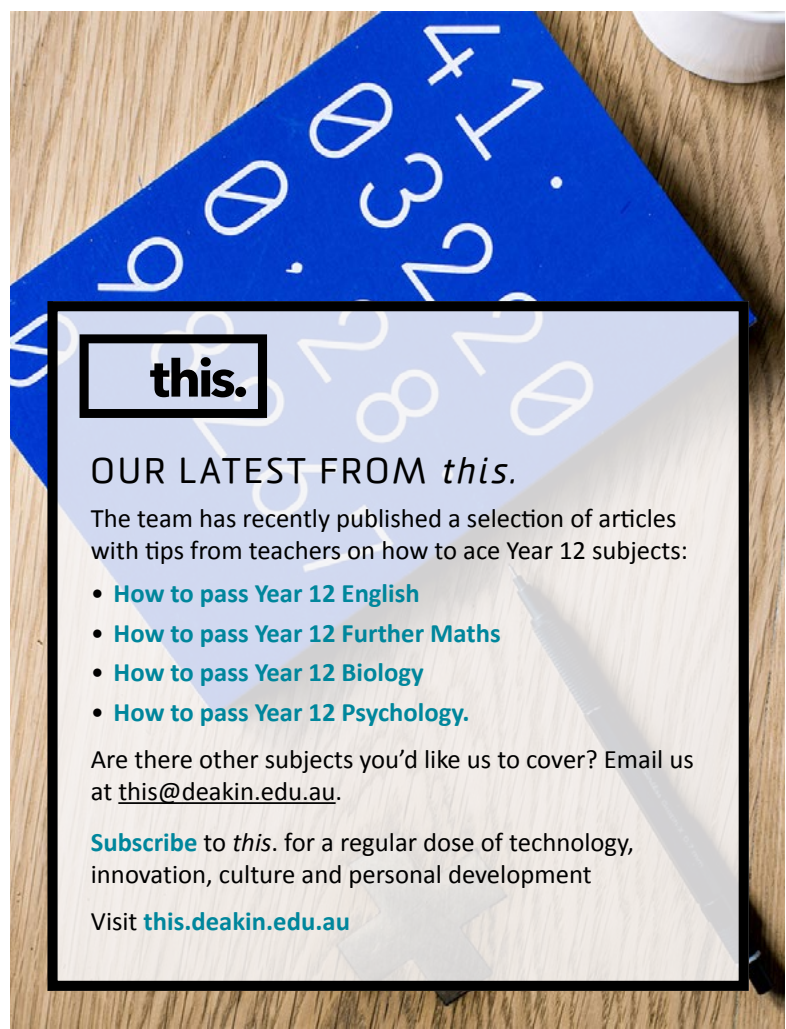

## Faculty of Arts and Education (cont.)

### ► CASPer entry requirements for initial teacher qualifications

Deakin is proud to be integrating CASPer as a requirement of our admission process for initial teacher qualifications. Combined with existing knowledge-based measures (GPA, standardised test scores), CASPer helps program leaders make more informed and data-driven admission decisions, resulting in stronger, higher quality students and graduates.

The purpose of the CASPer assessment is to determine students' non-academic suitability for teaching. It is designed to measure personal/professional characteristics like ethics, empathy, communication, resilience, judgement, teamwork and more, and provides an opportunity for students to demonstrate their personal characteristics and how these are suited to a teaching career. The assessment takes about one hour and comprises approximately 10 situational-based questions, which are presented in video format. Students can sit the test in the comfort of their own home, at a time that suits them. Completion dates are still to be confirmed and we will announce these as soon as they are available.

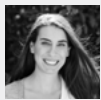

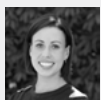
