2012 LOTE Method Bursary APPLICATION FORM



Bursaries of **\$2,080.00** are available to support Deakin University students studying LOTE (Language Other Than English) methodology for **Chinese (Mandarin), Indonesian, Japanese or Korean** in one of the following courses in 2012:

- Master of Education (TLOTE)
- Master of Teaching (LOTE Method) or Graduate Diploma of Teaching (LOTE Method)
- Bachelor of Education (LOTE Method)
- Bachelor of Teaching (Secondary) (LOTE Method)

The bursaries are to support expenses associated with a study program, such as tuition fees, books, and living expenses.

Bursary applicants must meet the eligibility criteria for their course, and must follow the relevant course application procedures.

Bursary applicants must be Australian citizens or Permanent Residents.

Important Information

- Applications must be received no later than **Monday 5th December 2011**
- Information that you provide on this Application Form and in the additional requested documents is the only information that will be considered in the selection and ranking process.
- It is very important that you make sure you have given all the relevant information for each section on this form. If the Application Form is not complete you will be contacted to provide further information.
- The number of bursaries to be awarded is six (6).
- Bursaries are contingent on availability of places.
- The Centre for Teaching Asian Languages and Cultures is not responsible for arranging school placements.
