Jo has spent the past 8 years researching with children and young people using both quantitative and qualitative methods. Prior to joining the University of Hull in 2005 she managed an SRB funded research project investigating young people's entrepreneurialism before moving to the public health field where she led the development of an adolescent lifestyle survey. As research assistant with the Food Health and Education Research group Jo has led the development of a range of data generation methods to elicit the views of children and young people, including large scale quantitative surveys, interviews and focus groups and a variety of creative research methods. Jo is currently completing her doctorate, which focuses on the cultures of primary school dining rooms, and she has presented findings from this work internationally.
