Miscellaneous Travel Grant Information Sheet

Miscellaneous requests for travel grant support are available to students undertaking travel related to their studies that does not involve any of the specific programs or activities outlined in the Designated Travel Grants.

Eligibility

Applicants must be an Australian citizen or holder of an Australian permanent visa.

Students must be currently enrolled in a Faculty of Arts and Education course.

The planned activity must be course-related, but not necessarily require enrolment in a formal unit.

Priority will be given to applicants whose planned travel aligns with the defined strategic objectives and activities as set out in the Faculty and School Operational Plans.

Preference will be given to those applicants:

- who are in receipt of a Centrelink benefit (Austudy, Newstart Allowance, etc); and
- for whom this will be their first international experience.

Applicants for whom the language of the country of destination is their native language will be ineligible.

Selection Criteria

The following criteria will be taken into account:

- Academic merit based on WAM (Weighted Average Mark);
- A personal statement outlining the student's reasons (personal, professional and academic) for undertaking the international study experience;
- Willingness to assist in promotional activities to prospective students on return from overseas (written reports, presentations, speaking engagements, etc); and
- If applicable, proof of relevant Centrelink benefit.

Consideration

The Experiential Learning Officer will consider all applications according to these criteria.

Value

\$1000 to cover travel and accommodation costs.

Number per year

Twenty-three in total.
