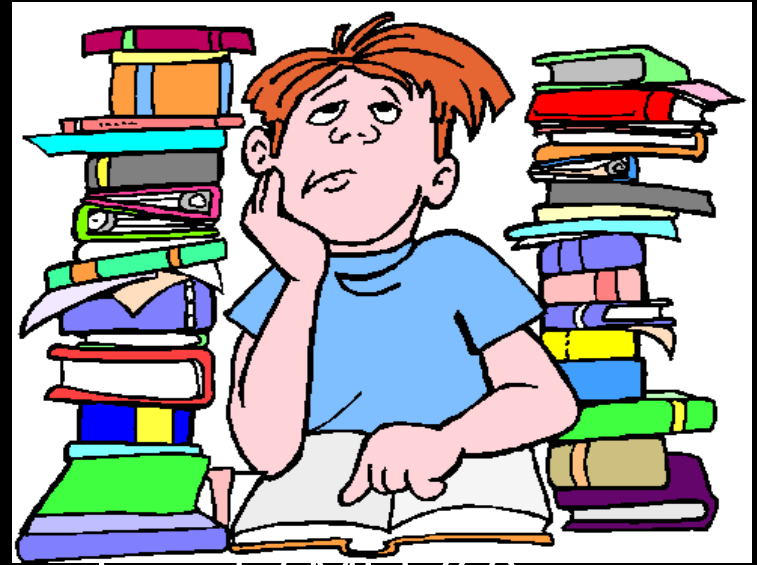


ISP program structure

1. Coursework in Australia – Nov to Dec 2012

Two undergraduate and a PG equivalent unit are offered:

- MFT306 International Finance & Investment / MFT760 International Finance
- MET303 International Trade
(and the option of an additional credit point by completing a two week intensive in Aarhus, Denmark in January prior to the tour component of the program)

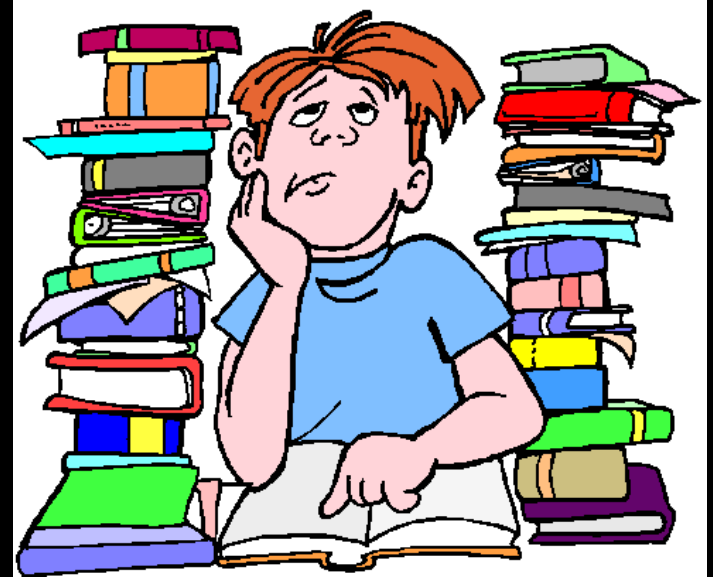


ISP Program structure

1. Coursework in Australia – Nov to Dec 2012

Intensive study mode

- series of seven three-hour classes per unit commencing November 12th and completing early December at Melbourne Campus at Burwood on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays for finance units, and Tuesdays and Thursdays for economics unit
- Exam 50% - Dec 10th-14th
- Intelligence Report 10% - Dec 20th

Coursework in Australia

'Intelligence report'

- Group work, completed on one of the institutions to be visited
- Submitted prior to the trip
- You will be expected to take part in all planned visits.
- You will be required to submit an assignment after completion of the overseas component, in late Feb



International visitation program

- Depart in January 2013 for three weeks.
- The program includes formal visits to financial institutions, corporations, multilateral government organizations and regulators in the following places*:
 - Dubai
 - London
 - Paris
 - Frankfurt
 - Geneva
 - Aarhus
- Host institutions will speak to students on predetermined topics relating to international finance and international trade.

What Else?

- **Taking Expressions of Interest now!**
- **Applications**
- Students must enrol in at least one of the units offered with the program.
- A deposit of \$1000 is payable on application. Pay at Finance Central....then take receipt to Linda de Sousa(B) or Bruce Hoyle (G)
- Contact Linda De Sousa, School of AEF (Ib 4.109). She will advise on enrolment procedures
- Application forms are available on the School's web site www.deakin.edu.au/buslaw/aef.
- Refund terms and conditions apply.
- The program is limited to 26 students. A minimum of 20 students is required.
- Students can stay longer in Europe after the trip - need to organise with Reho (travel agent)



Estimated costs



- Students are required to pay for the overseas component of the program in addition to relevant unit fees.
- Trip - estimated cost of \$7,500*
- includes flights, rail tickets, transfers and accommodation (twin share, three/four star hotels), breakfasts, welcome and farewell dinners, travel insurance, selected tours in various cities, airport taxes and fuel surcharges.
- Visa costs are additional if applicable. Students will need extra funds to meet daily personal costs such as meals and spending money.
- * **Confirmed \$500 discount per student is available until Sept 7th -first 20 students only. Final balance is due October 11th 2012.**
- **There are no tuition fees for the 2 week intensive in Denmark. Student accommodation will be available. Students who take this option will travel earlier than the rest of the group and will not take part in the Dubai visits. They will join the rest of the group in Aarhus at the end of their intensive**
- **Australian resident students who take up the Denmark intensive option may be eligible for a HECS O/S loan.**
