The University of Hyderabad is one of India's elite universities. It is a small institution focusing mainly on postgraduate courses and research, located in a serene and protected environment 20 km from the city. Hyderabad, the state capital of Andhra Pradesh, is rapidly modernising centre where Hindu and Islamic civilizations mingle with the contemporary IT culture.

The University of Hyderabad has a well-established Study in India Program (SIP) that caters for more than fifty US and European upper-level undergraduate students each semester. The University of California has been sending students to Hyderabad since 2001. Deakin students in the Faculty of Arts and Education are now able to join this program.

A wide range of units are available across many disciplines, including Indian languages, English literature, philosophy, history, political science, economics, sociology, anthropology, folk culture studies, theatre arts, painting, print-making, sculpture, dance, media studies, management as well as all science courses. The autumn semester runs from late July till early December and the spring semester from early January to early May.
