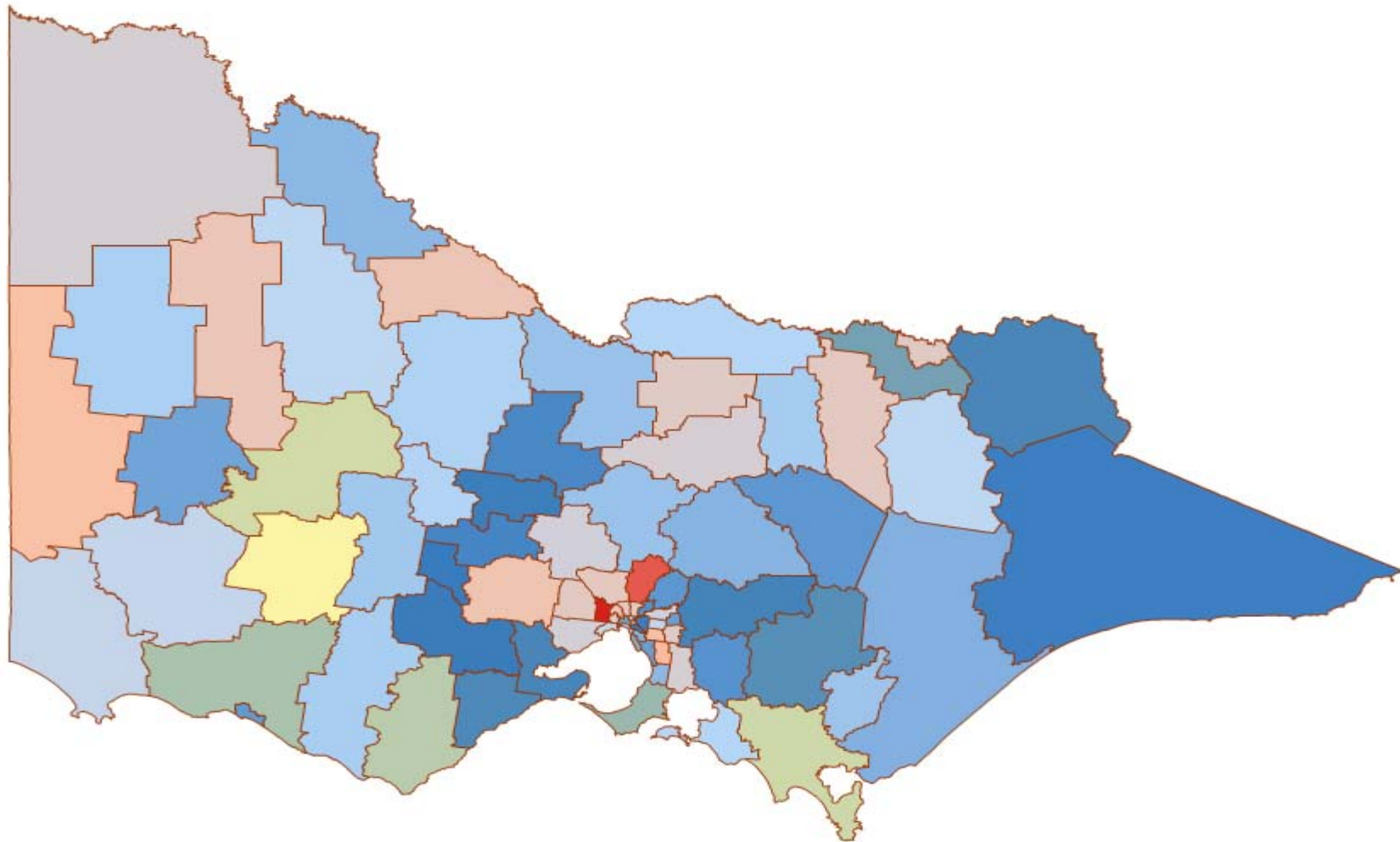

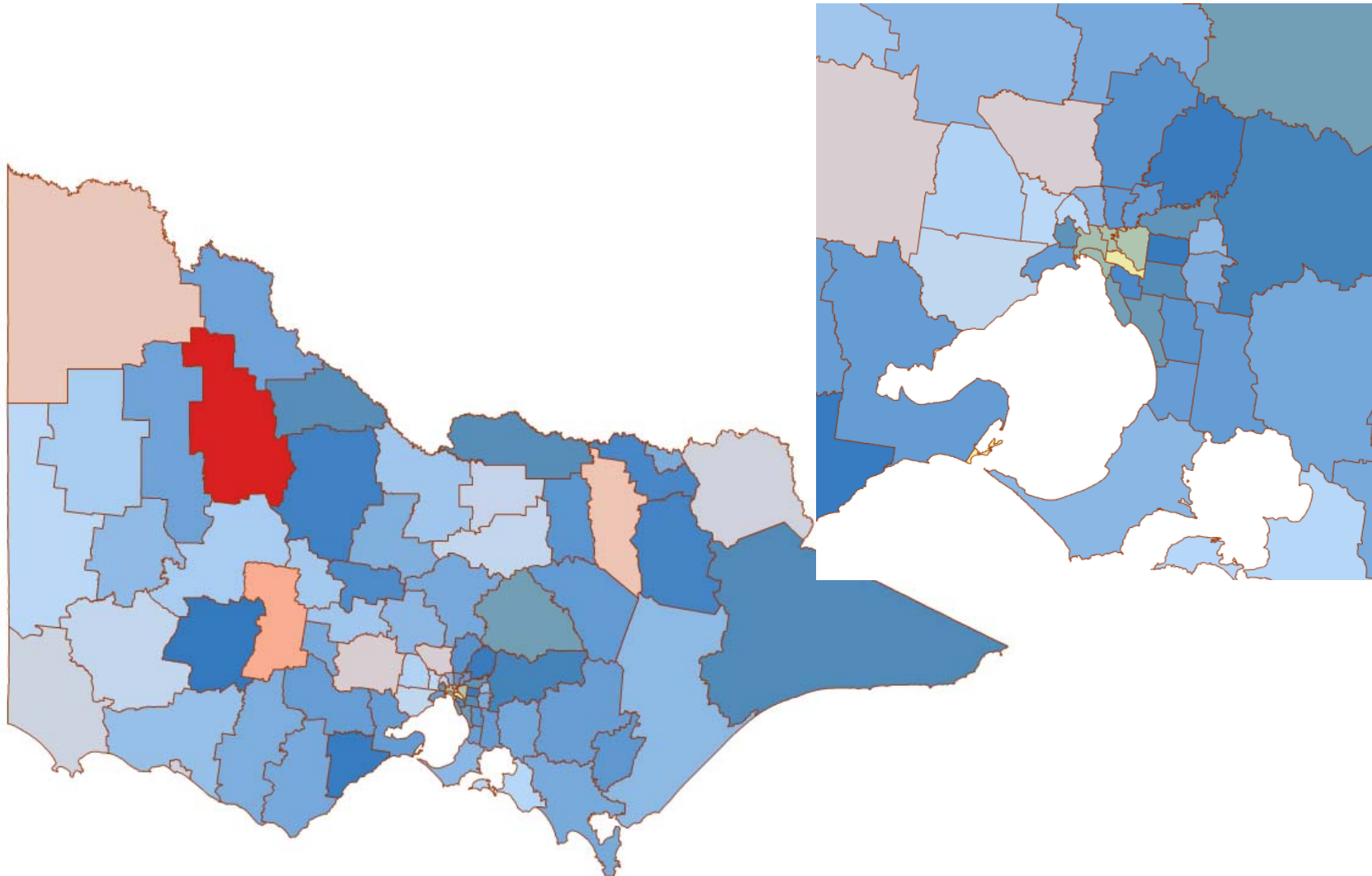

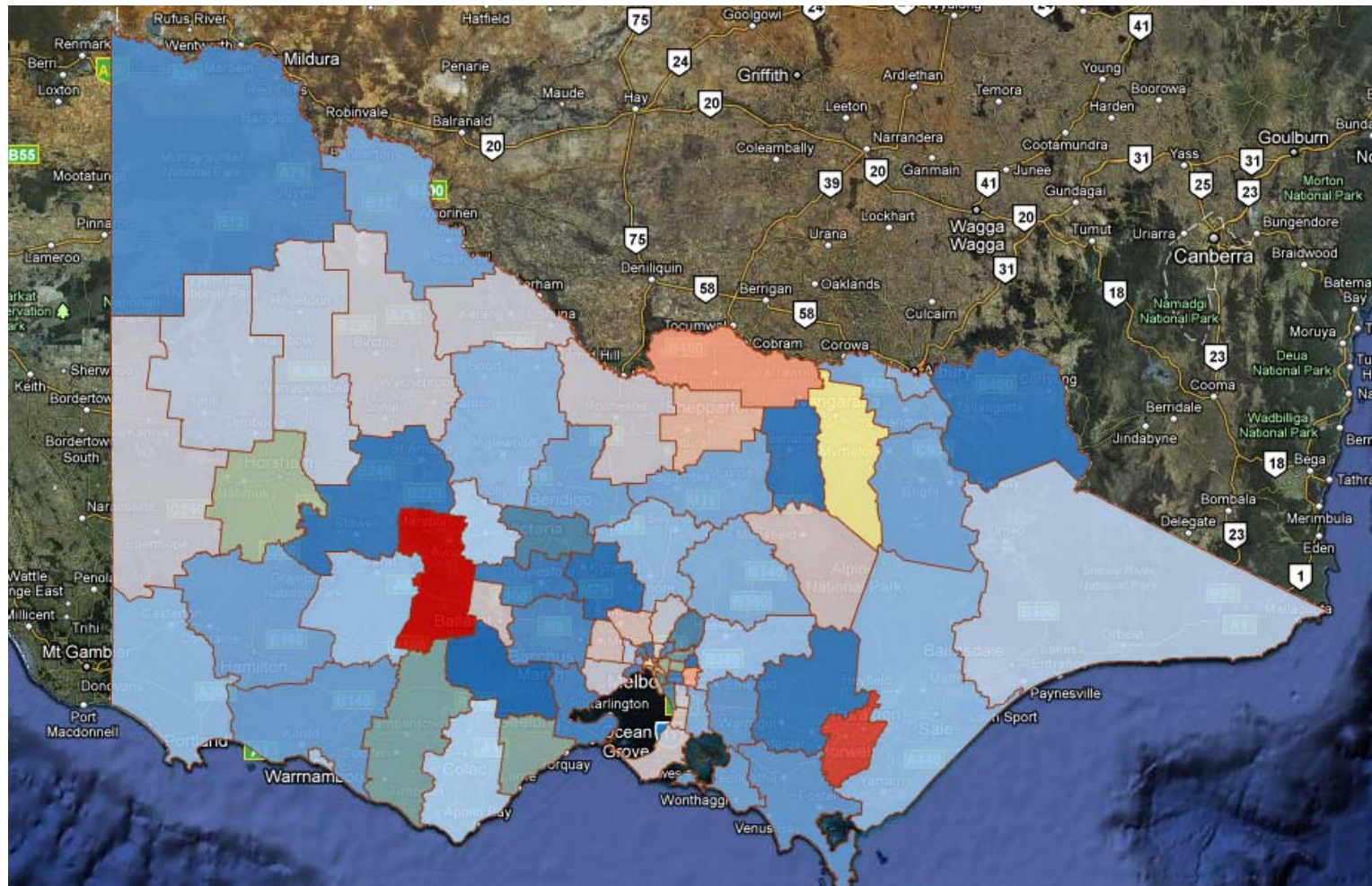
Blood Glucose Test in Last Two Years (Over 50 years)



Obese Adults Males

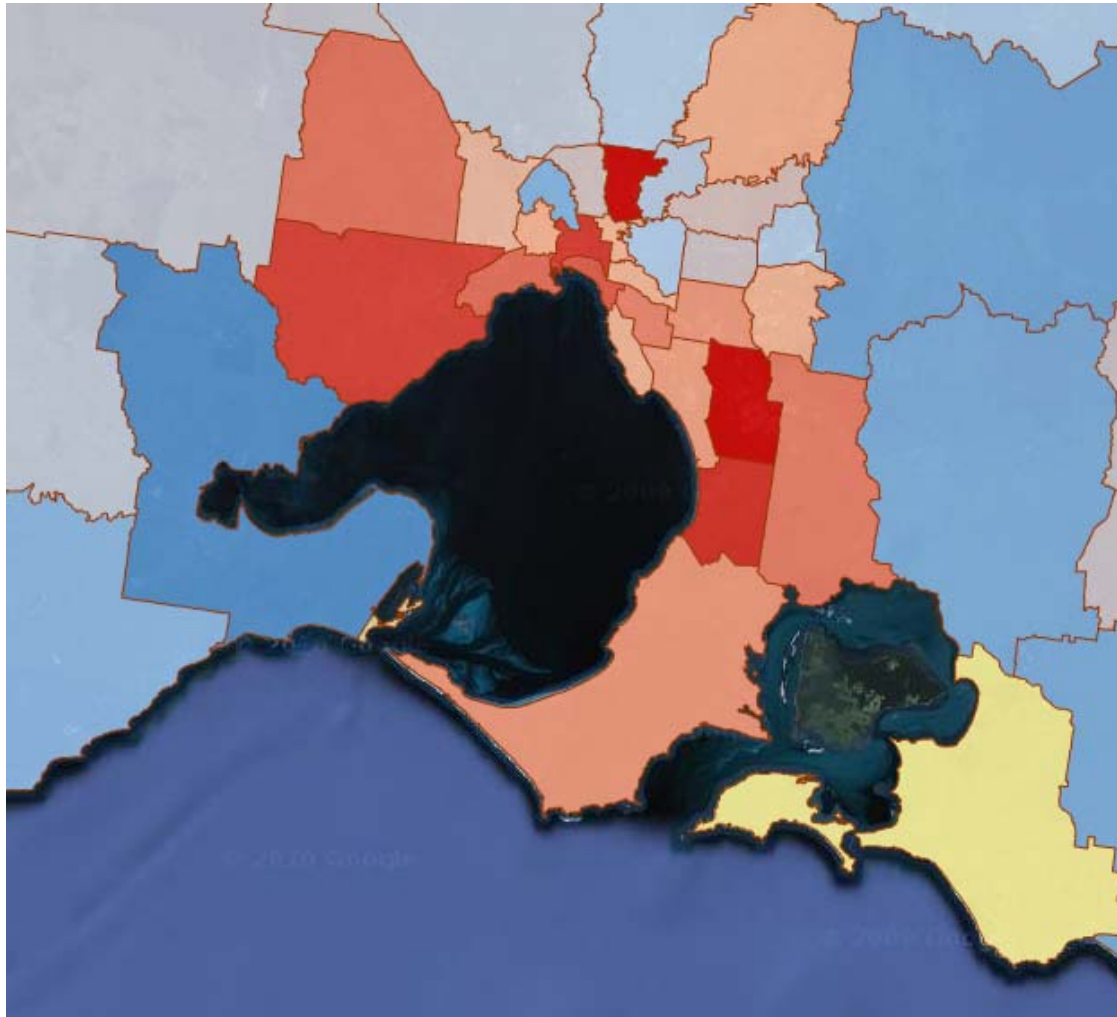


Current Daily Adult Smokers
