To be eligible for this scholarship you must:

- be an Australian citizen or holder of an Australian permanent humanitarian visa.
- be a future student enrolled full time in the Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery in a Commonwealth Supported Place.
- be able to demonstrate financial disadvantage.
- agree to your name being released to the Dr Gilbert M Davis Trust if your application is successful.

Selection criteria:

- The terms of the award state that applicants who have lived in the Shire of Indigo, (the location of Dr Davis' practice) should be favoured.
- Students, who have already received a scholarship or award, including students with Medical Rural Bonded Scholarships, are not eligible to apply.
- Applicants who meet the eligibility criteria will be assessed (by a panel from the Deakin School of Medicine) through a competitive process on the basis of academic merit.
- Applications of more than 300 words will not be considered.
