Developments in 2009

- Implemented Single Sign On, which enables students to access library resources via the student portal without having to re-authenticate. Unfortunately SSO will not work with Encore (unless everybody accesses Encore via the portal, but that is not possible for us because the portal is for students only), so users need to log in again in Encore. Ill are working on this issue.
- Tested and implemented the Recommend function in Acquisitions. The Suggest An Item form in the WebOPAC passes through to Millennium Acquisitions, where staff can approve or deny the request which automatically sends an email to the requester. Not using the "Approve and Acquire" functionality to create orders.
- Upgraded to Encore 3.0 in June.
- Upgraded to Release 2009A in June.
- Purchased Legato Networker Client interface, which interfaces with Legato Networker software used for system backup. Will use to backup the main library server and the Encore server.
- Trying to implement AirPAC for Smartphones, however this requires the Apache Web Server which is not currently compatible with SSO. Ill are working on a solution.
- Purchased the Program Registration module (class bookings management) but this also requires the Apache Web Server which is not currently compatible with SSO. Ill are working on a solution.
