2. Changes in 2009

- 2.1 **Upgraded production database to Release 2007 1.2.** Fairly smooth upgrade except for FTP problems for webopac files and interaction with Oracle Financials database due to the closure of port 21.
- 2.2 **Extended Approval Plan** workflows in production. New load tables for firm orders and approval plan through two vendors. Output of acquisitions data from YBP Gobi ordering website being loaded via data exchange.
- 2.3 **Electronic Serials Invoicing** in production.
- 2.4 **Label printing.** New Toshiba thermal transfer label printers (TEC B-SV4) purchased and print templates for monographic spine labels set up in Millennium. New workflows implemented to replace INNOPAC spine label printing on dot matrix printers. Java programming in print templates looks for slash (/) character in call number and replaces it with a new line. Label of location code can be printed onto label. This is much more flexible and efficient.
- 2.5 **RSS Feed Builder** installed and a number of [RSS feeds](#) set up and in production on website for new materials added to the collections by subjects and formats as well as new records created by the eRecords Project for retrospective cataloguing.
- 2.6 **Web Access Management.** Ebsco databases and *Who's Who in Australia* added to list of databases available via [remote access](#) for NSW residents.
- 2.7 **Staff loans** moved from a paper-based system to the Millennium circulation system.
- 2.8 **Early English Books Online (EEBO)** MARC records for online full text loaded - 102,959 in total. This enables title-level access to works published in the eighteenth century and encourages clients to gain access electronically rather than trawling through microfilm.
- 2.9 **Serials Solutions ebooks** loaded each month in addition to records for online serials. Allows for links to the online text at a title-level in the catalogue.

2.10 **New material type “online” graphic** implemented to distinguish between print and online versions of the same work.

3. Forthcoming events

In progress 2009:

- MARC records with 635,989 distinct ISBNs uploaded to LibraryThing in preparation for new service including tag clouds in web catalogue and links between similar titles. In development on training server, due live at end November.
- Loading of Eighteenth Century Books Online (ECCO) records planned for late 2009.

Planned or investigating for 2010:

- Preparation for RDA implementation in late 2010
- NCIP development proposal under discussion.
- Erequesting investigation – adding requesting feature from public catalogue to replace carbon paper stack-request slips.
