2. Developments in 2009

- implemented Patron Reading History and My Lists features in WebPAC (but not PIN verification as planned)
- re-set parameters for PTypes and Loan Rules, following consolidation of ITypes in 2007
- revised Contention Groups in order to 'quarantine' a select number of user licenses for service points
- relocated IELTS and other high-use monographs to new 'local' collection so as to suppress within BONUS+ catalogue; created additional IType for this purpose
- edited load table for eBooks in order to use with EBL (Ebook Library) titles
- Cataloguing staff made decision to create a suppressed item record for online version of title where there is already item record for print version so WebPAC will display for all campuses whenever patron scopes to one campus
- Acquisitions staff began processing e-invoices for YBP; not yet possible for JBLS due to GST factor
- established in-house wikis for Library Systems Group and Millennium to facilitate communication with Library staff and management
- training - nil

3. Forthcoming plans for 2010

- migrate to new server (Linux system under VMware configuration)
- UB in the process of replacing and consolidating its backup and recovery systems to a single enterprise wide data backup and recovery system; this will result in change from current use of Legato NetWorker Client interface
- upgrade to Release 2009B
- development partner for Encore Reporter
- change parameters of short loan collection from 3 Day to 7 Day
- acquire Scopes for selected Collections (in addition to Campus locations)
- investigate for possible purchase:

 - Single Sign On
