2. Developments in 2010

- migration of server to Red Hat Linux 4 on VMWare
- concurrent installation of API required by implementation of enterprise grade backup and recovery system for the University's corporate ICT systems, thus replacing Legato NetWorker Client interface
- switched to Print Templates to create customised spine labels so that EPSON printers used by cataloguers could be replaced with portable Brother printers (model QL-570)
- added 200,000 Holdings records to allow for expansion of e-resources in ERM
- purchased additional SIP2 licenses for two new 3M units (check-out only)
- switched to Automatic Request Processing with Title-level holds
- purchased customised Export table to enable full record loads and regular updates to Primo (Ex Libris) discovery layer from 2011
- continued in Australian development partnership with III for Encore Reporter; focus on reports designed to meet CAUL statistical reporting requirements

3. Forthcoming plans for 2011

- implementation of Millennium Inter-Library Loans
- implementation of Millennium Load Scheduler for daily patron record loads, regular updates to Primo, and automating some monthly statistic gathering processes
