2. Developments in 2011

- further customisation of Print Templates: for Acquisitions (A4 manual order form) and Circulation (Hold Paging slips) – logged request for interim fix for 'ncorrelator web service' error caused by iReport software
- purchased Unlimited Data License – plan to cease archiving order records due to change to Acquisitions/Cataloguing workflow for YBP outsourcing project (Extended Approval Plan for shelf-ready books)
- ceased membership of Australian development partnership with III for Encore Reporter in September
- Cataloguing Librarian attended Load Profile training at Uni of Sydney in May
- clean-up of system codes associates with closure of the physical library at the Stawell campus in early 2011; it has been replaced by a 'request and delivery' service from our other campus libraries at Mt Helen, SMB and Horsham

3. Forthcoming plans for 2012

- investigate Unicode storage
- implementation of WebPAC for mobile devices (AirPAC, LibraryAnywhere)
- extend scoping to collections by subject areas, in addition to current scopes according to campus libraries
- implement new Bib Locn for 'online in conjunction with creating separate records for the same item where there is electronic version and print version (currently merge both into single Bib)
