2. Changes in 2011

2.1 Upgraded training and production databases to Release 2009B

1.3. Patch applied by III. This has fixed a number of bugs but also introduced a number of new bugs, for example, error messages are being received for every Patron API transaction and WebBridge statistics are unable to be downloaded successfully.

2.2 House of Commons Parliamentary Papers. MARC records for online full text loaded – 184,792 records. This enables title-level access to works published by the British House of Commons from the seventeenth century to 2003 and allows 24 hour client access.

2.3 Web Access Management. A number of new databases including 19th Century UK Periodicals, Berg Fashion Library, Bibliography of British and Irish History, The Economist Historical Archive, Financial Times Historical Archive Road to IELTS, Picture Post Historical Archive and Oxford Language Dictionaries Online were added to the list of databases available via [remote access](#) for NSW residents. 2.4 Migration of WebFeat to 360 Search almost completed with plans to implement search box on eresources pages.

2.5 Ebook Library. An initial batch of 2,582 MARC records for ebooks loaded, with regular monthly updates. EZProxy authentication implemented (including two new VM servers and wildcard SSL certificate) to meet vendor requirements.

2.6 Investigation of resource discovery tools in progress.

2.7 Refurbishment of State Reference Library 700,000 items amended to prevent requests from catalogue while closed. Reconfiguration of Mitchell Library stacks required another 105,000 item changes. New location codes for specific SRL reference collections, such as HSC Information and new Travel section.

2.8 Upgrade of Airpac to Airpac for Smartphones. Required multi-domain SSL certificate.

2.9 Reference Database export of data (41,695 records) for AIATSIS digitisation project of the *Koori Mail* newspaper.

- 2.10 **Staffing.** Systems Librarian appointed.
- 2.11 **Enterprise API** installed. Operational on training.
- 2.12 **Dewey Index** search in catalogue switched on
- 2.12.1.1 **Acquisitions claims letters** moved to print templates, eradicating the need for special stationery.
- 2.13 **Inventories** generated from the system for stock take.
