### Sorters

In 2011 we installed more returns sorters (LibRetto supplied by QLS)

### Linked Ecommerce

Linked Ecommerce was implemented for fines payment and is popular for offsite usage.

Self bookings was introduced for discussion and study rooms in some branch libraries

### Discovery (Ebsco)

2011 saw the official launch of the Ebsco discovery layer at the University of Melbourne (after a long period of development and review). Data from Millennium, SFX and Digitool is exported to Discovery (as we have called it) regularly. Integration with a third party discovery layer has its challenges.

### BONUS+

UMELB usage of BONUS+ continues to grow. In our 4<sup>th</sup> year of membership our requests have increased by 17% from 2010 and loans to partners have increased by 21%.

In May 2011, our patrons submitted the highest number of monthly requests in the life of the BONUS+ scheme, with 3340 requests.

**Branch refurbishment**

A new branch library opened in 2011, the Giblin Eunson Library, covering Economics, Business & Education. This entailed the move of approx. 135,000 items into the new premises, and approx. 75,000 items into offsite storage

Branch refurbishment continues from 2010, with significant moving, weeding and temporary closure of collections.
