Developments in 2011

- Implemented Program Registration in March 2011. We don't have many programs so far, less than 30. Not totally happy with the software, especially the lack of customisation for emails.
- Implemented Summon in 2011, went live at the beginning of semester 2 in July. It is the default main search, which has confused people because it brings up so many results. Catalogue entries link through to the WebPAC. Encore is now hidden in the background, and will possibly be discontinued.
- Implemented Scheduler in April 2011, mainly to schedule Summon updates, and also for patron loads. Patron loads working well because the same filename is always used. Summon updates are more difficult as the filename has to be changed, plus the date in the review file strategy.
- Library management was restructured at the end of 2010. No redundancies, just a reorganisation of existing staff. Reporting to the University Librarian (Ralph Kiel) there are now two Associate Librarians, the Associate Librarian Services (Frances O'Neil) and the Associate Librarian Information Resources Systems and Infrastructure (IRSI – Adrian Gallagher). Reporting to Frances are the Manager, Campus Libraries (Garry Potter) and the Manager, Learning Education and Research Support (Jane Miller). Reporting to Adrian are the Manager, Corporate Services (Gehan Aboud), the Manager, Information Resources and Collection Services (Brian Tyrrell) and the Manager, Digital and Student Computing Services (Angela D'Souza). I am in Angela's team.
- Planning to implement ArticleReach and trial SMS Alerts in 2012.
