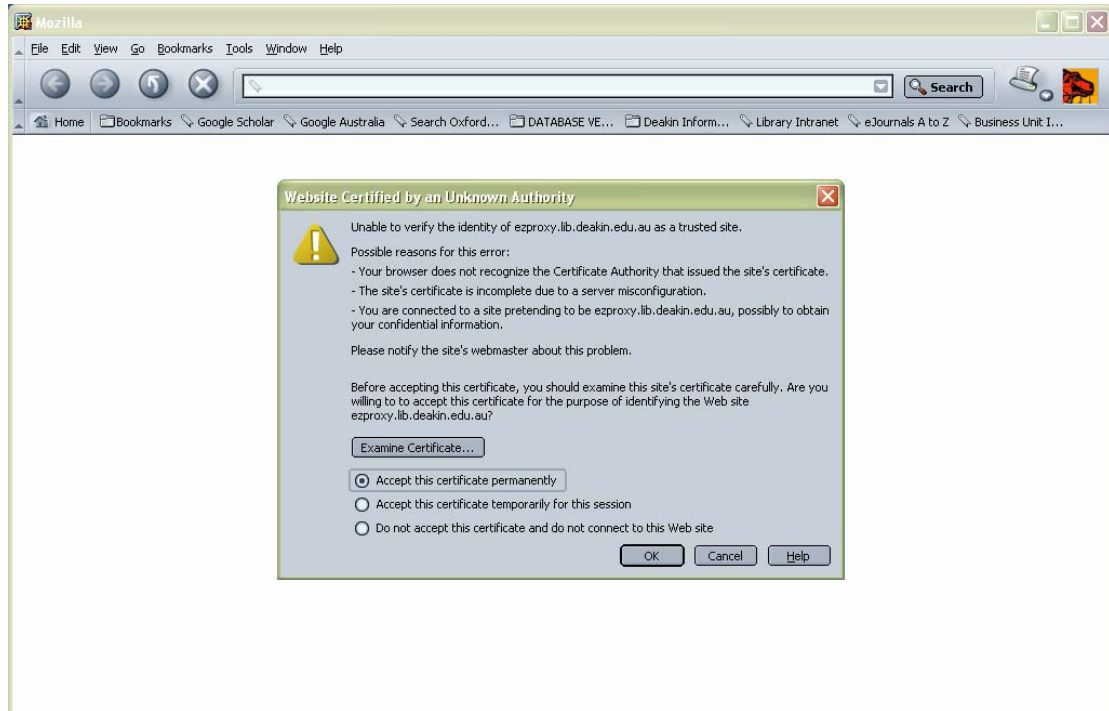


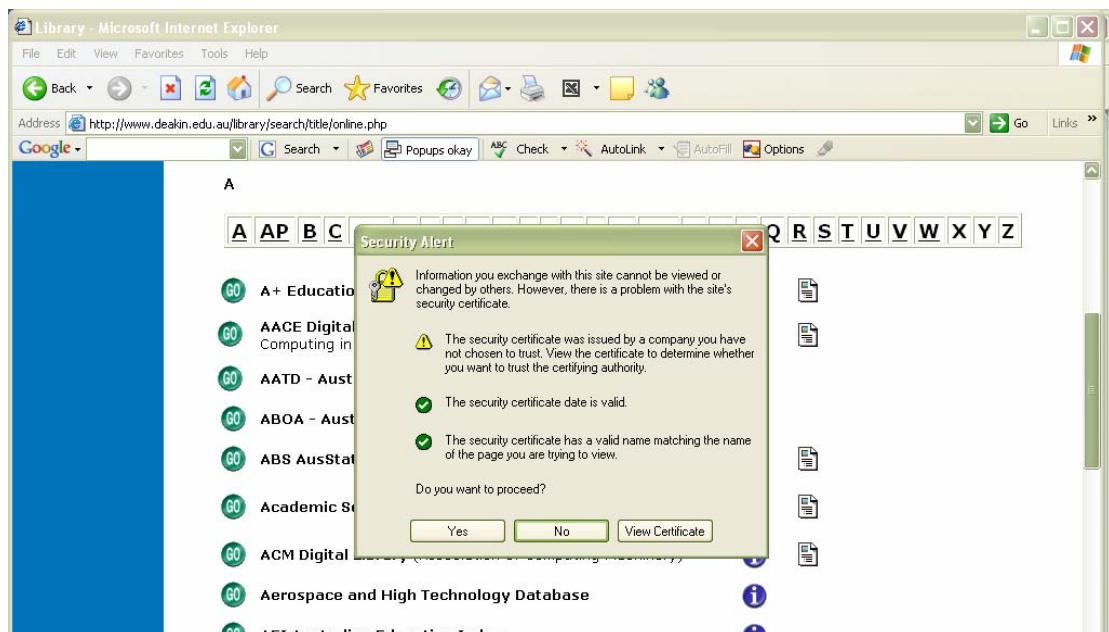
EZproxy security certificates – annual renewal

Ezproxy uses security certificates in the process of authenticating Deakin users of online library resources. The certificate needs to be ‘re-installed’ each year.

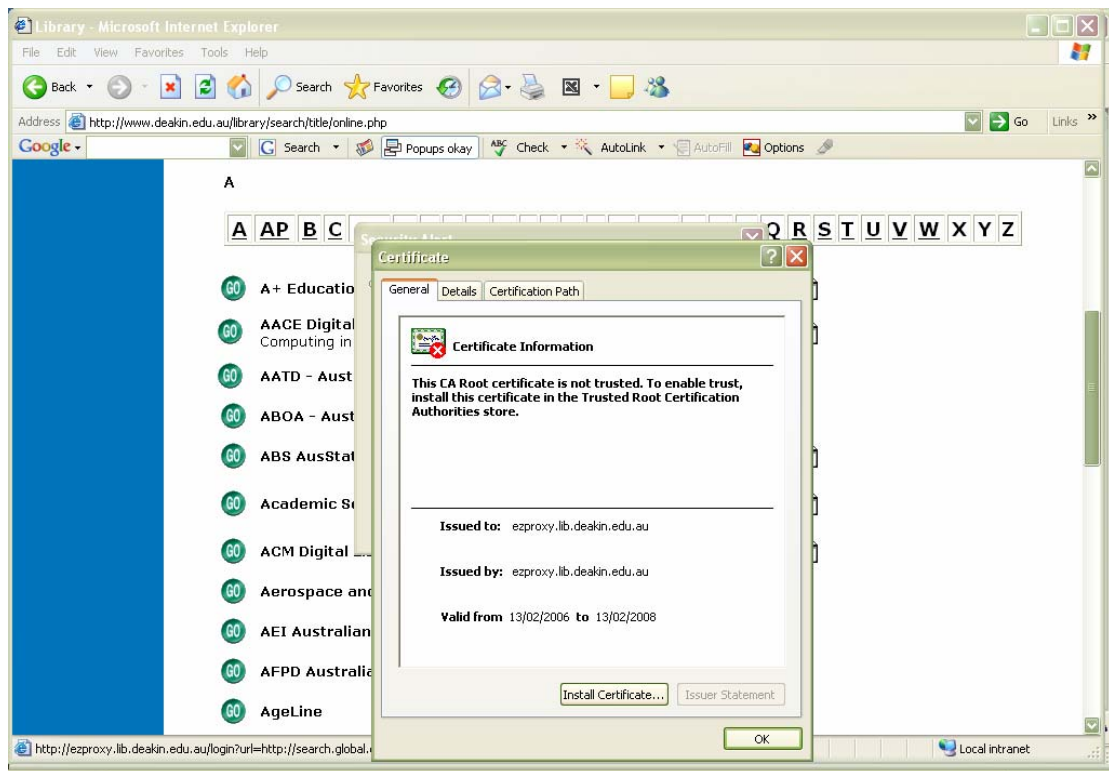
Mozilla will prompt with a screen like the one below. Simply check the radio button next to the “Accept the certificate permanently” option, and click OK.



Internet Explorer requires a more detailed process to accept the new Ezproxy certificate. At the screen below, click “View certificate”.

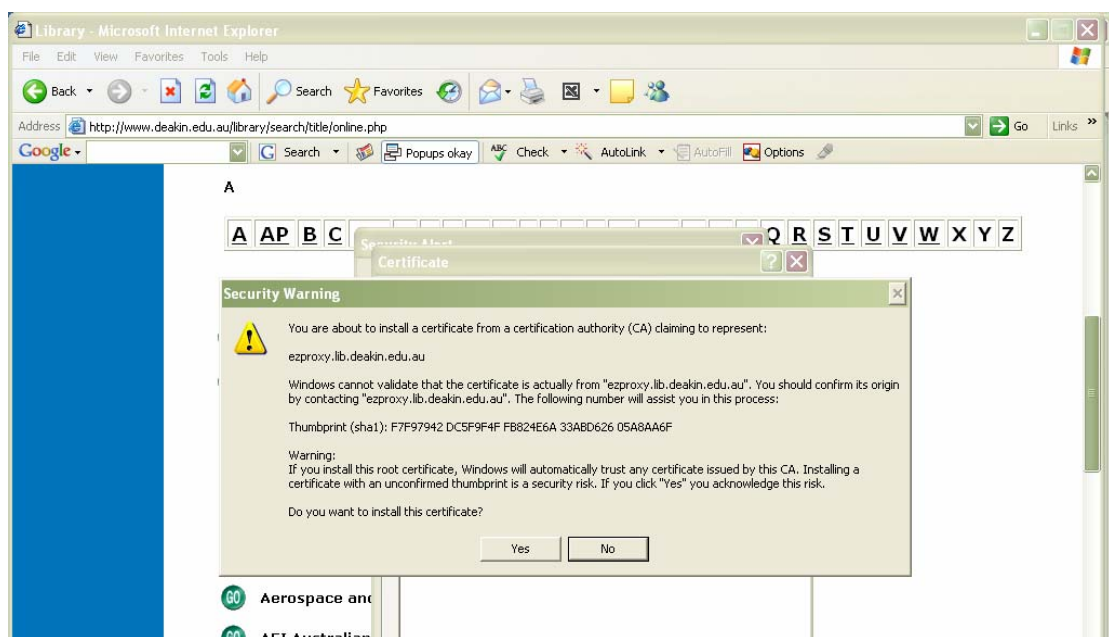


Then at the next screen, click “Install certificate”.



You may be prompted to use the Windows certificate Wizard. If so the default options are OK to use.

At the “Security warning” screen below, click “Yes”. The Ezproxy certificate is safe to install so that future authentication is easier.



At the screen below, click “Yes”.

The security certificate will be installed and you will be prompted to authenticate with your Family name, Library ID number, and Library PIN.
