

Deakin University Resident Parking

1. Resident parking

Purple Permit Zone parking is available for students living on campus. Purple Permits may only be fixed to a vehicle registered in the resident's name or owned by a member of the resident's family that is for the student's personal use.

Parking restrictions at Residences apply 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Parking is not reserved and is strictly on a first in, first parked basis.

Purple Parking Permits only apply at your campus of residence, but they also allow you to park in any General Permit parking bay at any campus. If there are no vacant General Permit Parking bays you may:

- park in a free car park if space is available (Geelong Waurm Ponds Campus Car Park 11 and the Warrnambool Campus Car Park 11 - Dry Weather Car Park only)
- make alternative arrangements to park off campus

If you are arriving or departing in the dark, you may contact Security to arrange a free escort to and from your vehicle.

Vehicles are not to be parked outside marked parking bays. Vehicles parked in these areas may be issued with a Parking Infringement Notice. Illegally parked vehicles cause inconvenience and frustration for other drivers, damage to grounds, safety hazards for pedestrians and other vehicles, and may obstruct emergency access to Deakin University facilities.

2. Authorisation

You will need to obtain an authorisation from the Residence Office to purchase a resident permit before you go to the Cashier.

3. Disabled / accessible parking

People with a **Category 1 Disabled Persons Parking Permit** issued by a local council may park in a Disabled Parking Bay. No additional permit is required.

4. Visitor parking

Visitors are not allowed to park in a Purple Permit Zone. Visitors may park in:

- time-limited bays for the time specified on the parking sign: or
- General Permit Zone bays (with an appropriate parking permit between 8.30 am and 4.30 pm, Monday to Friday). Permits are not required after the days and times specified on the parking signs.

Subject to availability, visitors may also use the free car parks at the Geelong Waurm Ponds Campus (Car Park 11), and at the Warrnambool Campus (Car Park 11 - Dry Weather Car Park).

5. Permit transfers

Deakin University does not refund parking permits. If you no longer require your permit, you may sell it to another Deakin University student resident. Any transfer of ownership of a permit is a private transaction between the seller and buyer and does not involve Deakin University, however for security reasons the seller and buyer must both inform the Residence Office of the change of ownership.
