Discovery Projects DP25 - Key changes 1

Now a 2 stage process:

Stage 1: Expression of Interest:

- Simplified application, to include Project team, participating organisations and basic design of proposed research program.

- Eol Assessment criteria: Investigators/Capability 30%

Project Quality and Innovation 70%

- no NIT, no budget, no medical statement at this stage- all at Full Application stage

- EoIs assessed by Assessors from ARC College of Experts (each CoE member assigned 50-60 EoIs)
 - can submit a Request not to Assess
- EoIs scored by CoE and ranked, expected top **20%** will be shortlisted and invited to submit a full application (expected success rate approx. 50%)



Discovery Projects DP25 - Key changes 2

Stage 2: Invited to proceed to full application

- Cannot change project team from those CIs/PIs listed at EoI stage

- Full Assessment assessed by Detailed Assessors
 - there will be an opportunity to address assessor comments through rejoinder process
- Assessments completed as per traditional process of Detailed Assessors, General assessors and SAC panels. No reference to EoI assessment

The ARC does not fund research with direct medical and or human health aims.

Disease - Any deviation or interruption of the normal structure or function of any part, organ or system (or combination thereof) of the body that is manifested by a characteristic set of symptoms and signs and whose aetiology, pathology and prognosis may be known or unknown.

Human Health Conditions - Pertaining to diseases (as defined above), syndromes, pathological conditions, injuries, signs, symptoms, problems and/or conditions that generally lead to contact with, or utilisation of, health services.

General considerations

- EoIs are working to extremely tight timelines
- Strongly suggest you make EARLY contact with your CIs and PIs and have any who do not have existing ARC RMS accounts to request their RMS accounts before EoIs open in RMS (go to <u>ARC RMS login in page</u> and select 'Request New Account'
 - Critical to have the right team in place at EoI as **NO** opportunity to change team makeup at full application
- Project limits for CIs do apply at EoI stage
- CIs can be named on no more than 2 EoIs, active projects held assessed as at 1 July 2025. CIs can only be on 2 concurrently funded projects under Discovery Program. Each EoI submission take up one of these slots. If concerned regarding your limits please contact DRG
- ARC Certification forms required at full application stage
- Deakin Research is **not** providing external review of EoIs
- Plan ahead and block out time now in your calendars in preparation of being shortlisted
