Please be advised that Deakin University has cancelled the offering of the Bachelor of Laws: Warrnambool Campus, 1400714061, Law (CSP). The cancelling of this course means that it is no longer available.

Deakin has drafted communication to send to students who listed the above course as one of their VTAC preferences for 2020 and has recommended students consider applying for the same course which is offered at:

- Cloud Campus 1400614061 (CSP)
- Melbourne Burwood Campus 1400514061 (CSP)

For students who have listed Bachelor of Laws, Warrnambool, as one of their VTAC preferences, their other course preferences will be considered within the normal VTAC processes and are unaffected by this change. No further action is required by affected students at this time. However, if they wish to do so, students also have an opportunity to review and change their course preferences by 14 December in time for the December selection round. There will be no automatic conversion of a Warrnambool law preference to a Geelong law preference.

New degrees in business and psychology

Deakin Accommodation – TO PARTICIPATE IN VTAC DECEMBER EARLY OFFER ROUND

During the December VTAC round offers, Deakin Residential Services will work closely with the University to ensure accommodation offers are reviewed and distributed to eligible students by Friday 20 December.

This will result in tight deadlines for processing of accommodation offers and therefore students who receive an accommodation offer as part of the December offer round will be required to accept and pay a deposit towards their accommodation within 48 hours of receiving their offer.

Deakin Residential Services will still be accepting applications during the December offer round period and will also be available to offer assistance over live chat, phone and email.

Applications are now open for Trimester 1 2020 and with 2700+ beds across four precincts, on-campus accommodation is available at each of our four campuses.

Deakin's on-campus accommodation provides the next generation of students with living / learning environments that enable them to pursue the best version of themselves. By opting to live on campus students are seeking a unique way to take this journey.
