Digital media

Work on briefs for real clients and discover what it takes to deliver campaigns to a deadline, whilst managing stakeholder expectations and dealing with unexpected events.

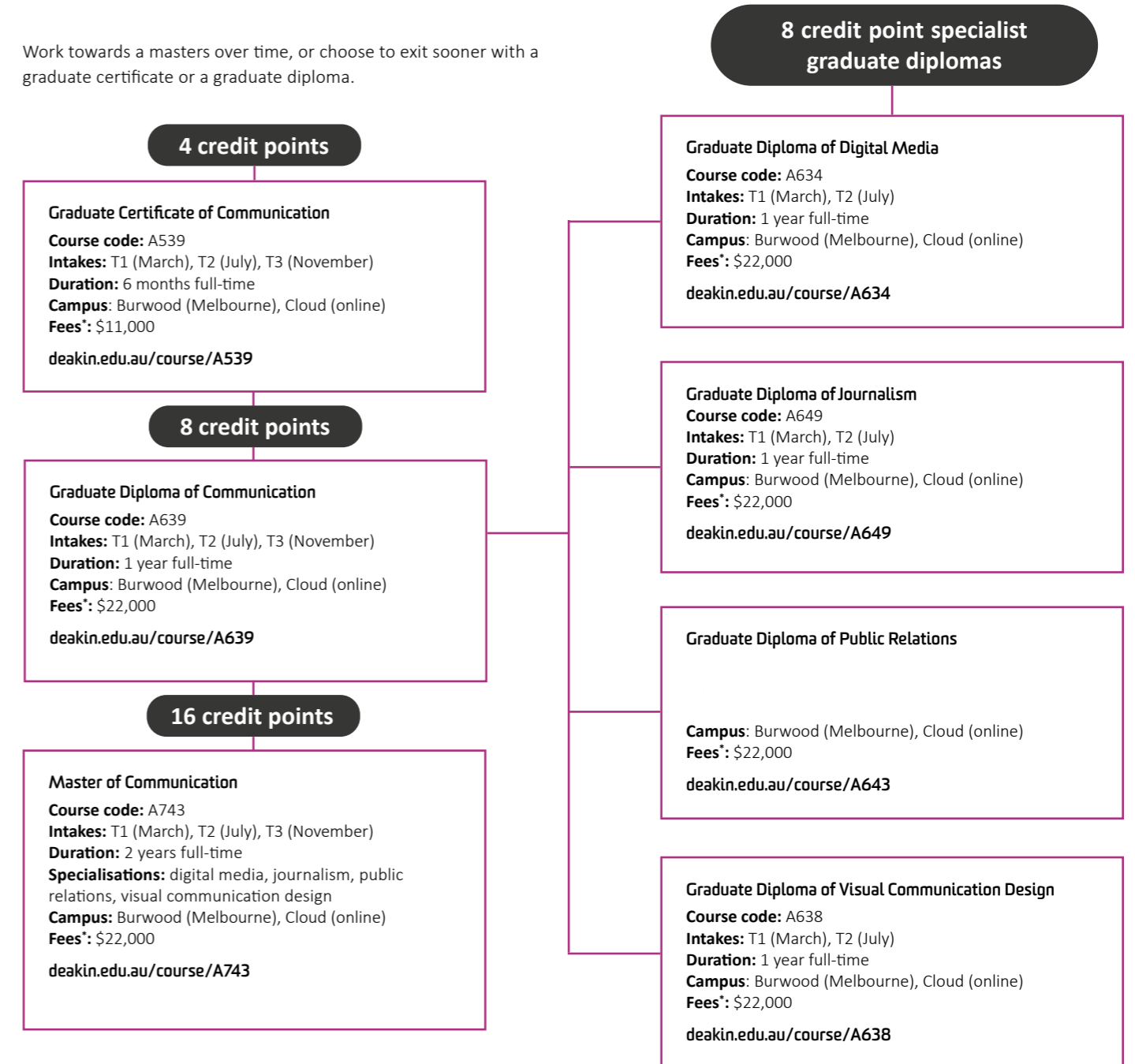
Visual communication
