My Bachelor degree does not appear on the form

This form shows only the pathway courses available from Deakin College to Deakin University. For any course that is not a pathway you need to:

- Apply for the next best course to your ultimate course
- Investigate course transferring after at least 4 credit points at Deakin University using your Deakin University WAM

When will I be made an offer?

You should get a conditional offer from Deakin University's Admissions and RPL area soon after you apply. This condition will set out when you will need to finish your studies at Deakin College by and your required WAM for entry to Deakin University.

How are courses at Deakin University selected?

When you apply to Deakin University from Deakin College it is selected purely on your Weighted Average Mark (WAM), including any fails you may have on your record. Deakin University cannot vary your WAM or the desired WAM from that advertised.

I will not meet the condition of my offer

If you know you will not meet the WAM then you have a few options:

- Wait until you get your confirmed marks and change your preferred course using the form at deakin.edu.au/ deakin-college-transfer.
- Select another course or campus now at deakin.edu.au/deakin-college-transfer.
- Have a chat to an adviser at Deakin College about other options. There are advisers at each Deakin College office.
 But get in early if you think this may happen as they book up!
- Deakin University are able to provide some support services. See deakin.edu.au/ life-at-deakin/support-services.

When will I enrol?

Following release of your results by Deakin College, Deakin University will check you have met conditions of entry, including meeting the required WAM for your chosen course. If you meet all entry requirements, you will receive your Letter of Offer for study within 12 days. At this time you will also receive your details on Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and details on how to enrol to Deakin University.

Entry requirements and intakes


