# Folio update for Deakin creative arts courses

From Trimester 1 2022, submitting a portfolio for one of Deakin's Creative Arts Courses will be optional.

Deakin uses a range of selection criteria for course entry. Applicants may submit an optional portfolio of work to showcase their talents and strengthen their application. The portfolio will be used to adjust a student's rank and increase their chances of being selected.

To be eligible for this adjustment, portfolios should satisfy the requirements specified at **deakin.edu.au/** portfolio-applications by the submission deadline

# Deakin Scholarship for Excellence

The Deakin Scholarship for Excellence rewards efforts not just in the classroom, but in the community too. It is for students who show exceptional promise within or beyond their academic achievements.

The scholarship offers financial support of \$5000 per year of a student's degree (based on full-time study), either as cash or towards tuition, or a combination of both.

Students need to demonstrate strong academic performance with an ATAR of 85 or more, or showcase their excellence in extracurricular activities in areas such as elite sport, the arts, volunteering contributions, community service or leadership, to be eligible to apply.

Applications can be submitted on the Deakin website and are due to open early September 2021. For more information on this scholarship please visit.

# Spotlight on work-integrated learning in business and law courses

Deakin Business School and Deakin Law School offer a range of work-integrated learning opportunities to enhance each student's job prospects with real-world experience during their studies.

Interns in Industry is an annual internship program run twice a year where students complete a business internship with a local eastern region business. This prestigious internship program sees Deakin Business School (DBS) collaborate with three city councils:
