Career Pathway Placements



Career Pathway Placements (often referred to as internships) are offered as part of PhD Xtra, to all domestic and international HDR students subject to the availability of placement opportunities.

Placement Rules

- Students must have successfully completed their confirmation of candidature
- Students must be progressing well in the HDR course no additional time will be granted on candidature timeframe
- Students cannot intermit their candidature to undertake a placement
- Placements must be endorsed by the academic supervisor
- · Placements are subject to University approval, and obviously that of the placement provider
- Placements must be related to the students' general field of study and in some cases must also align to the thesis topic
- Students can undertake a placement during candidature or whilst their thesis is under examination
- Students must record the placement in their Individual Learning Plan

- 1. Initiate a placement by identifying and contacting potential host organisations
- 2. Complete the Career Pathway Placement application form
