

Updates to the Bachelor of Business

The Bachelor of Business has a strong practical focus, provides work-integrated learning opportunities and equips you with the skills you need for the job you want. Designed to encourage you to learn through real experiences, you will integrate your knowledge, consolidate skills, tackle real problems, and reflect on the experience to develop your professional identity.

The Bachelor of Business is a three-year course (24 credit points), consisting of 10 credit points of core units, 8 credit points of a major and 6 elective units (which may include a 4 unit minor).

Majors include:

- business and digital communications
- entrepreneurship and innovation
- event management
- organisational psychology
- people management
- project management
- retail and supply chain management.
