The scholars

Since inception in 2016, 293 scholars have engaged in the VCPEP alongside their studies.

Scholars hail from metropolitan and regional Australia and around the world, coming together to study across all of Deakin's five campuses from the Cloud to Geelong and Warrnambool to Burwood.

In addition, study areas are broad. From Health to Business, Education to Engineering and beyond, scholars are completing a variety of courses within each of Deakin's four Faculties.

The VCPEP

The VCPEP includes a series of tailored activities to encourage scholars' personal, professional, and academic development.

Each year scholars have various touchpoints with the program, including workshops, meetings and social events, in addition to broader DeakinTALENT services.



Key program components include:

Academic Mentoring

Scholars are partnered with an Academic Mentor from their faculty to meet with each trimester for the duration of their course. Discussions range from study habits to major selection and discipline-specific niches, to the world of internships and careers beyond university.

Development Planning

Each trimester, scholars also meet with DeakinTALENT staff for development planning. Meetings provide the opportunity to reflect on their journey to date, while discussing achievements and challenges, and setting personal, professional, and academic goals.

Personal and Professional Challenges

Scholars also complete annual Personal and Professional Challenges to develop their skills and build experience in new and unfamiliar environments. In first year, Deakin-arranged Personal and Professional Challenges offer insights into authentic leadership and the future world of work. From second year, scholars design their own, aligned to their personal and professional development needs and aspirations.

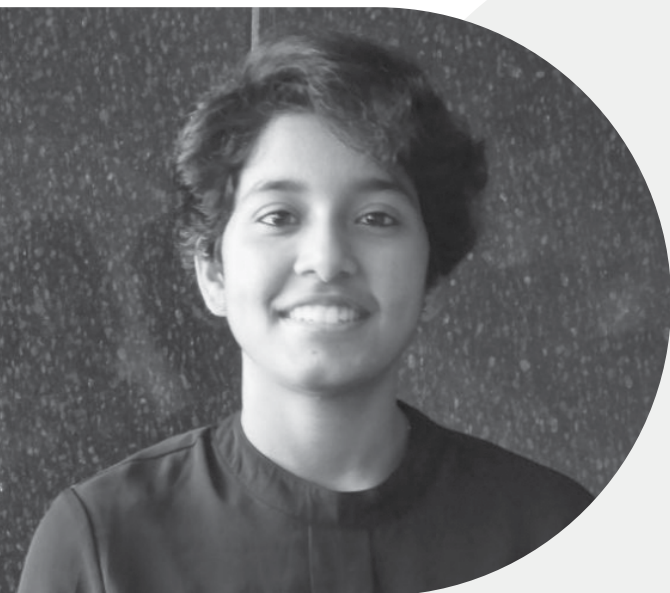
