

- 1. The Council may make, amend or revoke regulations prescribing or providing for:
  - (a) the use, control and superintendence of University property, premises, facilities and services;
  - (b) the administration and application of any and all property, whether real or personal, received by the University as a gift, grant, bequest or devise;
  - the conditions of or for any payments, awards, grants, fellowships, scholarships, prizes or exhibitions which may be made, awarded or provided from any property to which section 1(b) applies;
  - (d) the payment of fees and charges, the manner in which fees and charges shall be collected, and for any action that may be taken in case of non-payment of any such fees and charges; or
  - (e) any other matter for which it is necessary or expedient to prescribe or provide for the purposes of this Statute.
- 2. Regulations made under this Statute will come into effect when promulgated by being displayed on the University's official notice board.
