D303 course rules - In order to qualify for the award of Bachelor of Arts/Master of Teaching (Secondary)(D303), students must complete 36 credit points, comprising of 24 credit points from the Bachelor of Arts, and 12 credit points from the Master of Teaching:

- AAI018 Academic Integrity (0-credit-point compulsory unit);
- ELN010 LANTITE Literacy (0-credit-point compulsory unit); and
- ELN011 LANTITE Numeracy (0-credit-point compulsory unit).

Bachelor Level Studies:

Two approved Arts major sequences of at least 8 credit points each selected from: Anthropology, Arabic, Children's Literature, Chinese, Dance, Drama, History, Indonesian, Literary Studies, Media Studies, Philosophy, Photography, Politics and Policy Studies, Sociology, Spanish, Visual Arts

4 elective units selected from another of the groups of Arts major disciplines listed above (Students taking a major in Anthropology, Philosophy, Politics or Sociology must select 2 credit points of units in one of these areas or Geography/History among their electives);

4 credit points selected from Education Electives List A;

No more than 10 credit points at level 1; and

At least 4 credit points at level 3.

Postgraduate Level Studies:

- 7 core teaching units (8 credit points);
 - 2 curriculum study units in first teaching specialist area; and
 - 2 curriculum study units in second teaching specialist area.
- Completion of 60 days of supervised professional experience

GENERAL INFORMATION

Not all units are available in all study periods or mode of delivery. Full time study is typically three to four units (or credit points) each study period – this is a typical enrolment pattern. Trimester 3 is typically an optional study period - unless it's your first study period and/or a compulsory study period for your course (see your course structure in the [Handbook](#)).

If you have applied for or received credit for units as recognition of your prior learning (**RPL**), it may alter your course pattern and the units you need to undertake.

SPECIFIC COURSE INFORMATION

Compulsory zero (0) credit point units/programs/modules - Two zero (0) credit point units ELN010 and ELN011 as part of the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education (LANTITE) and AAI018 Academic Integrity (0-credit-point compulsory unit) in order to graduate from their course.

Students must complete all 24 credit points at undergraduate level to progress to postgraduate level study. A WAM of less than 60 results in an alternative exit from D303 with award A300 Bachelor of Arts.

*These units contribute towards the course requirement of 60 days of supervised professional experience (refer to handbook for number of days required in each unit indicated)
